This year marks the 13th National Police Memorial Day which will be held at St Paul's Cathedral in London on Sunday 25th September 2016. This annual event honours police officers throughout the United Kingdom who have given their lives in the line of duty.



Founded by Sergeant Joe Holness, QPM in 2001, National Police Memorial Day ensures

that fallen officers are never forgotten and that their unique, proud legacy is forever treasured.

"The British Police Service is renowned worldwide and its unique and priceless reputation is entirely a reflection of the professionalism of the men and women who proudly perform the role. Sadly, each year police officers give their lives in order that we may all live in peace. They place the safety of others above that of their own – they do so with pride and because they are the best," he said.

Each year the service is held at one of the four countries of the UK and this year's service will be at St Paul's Cathedral in London at 3pm. The event is open to everyone to attend but you **must**, for security reasons, register in advance to receive your invitation to the event.

How to register:

You will need to provide the following details when you register:

Full name and address of attendees

When registering a group, invitations can be sent to one address, provided that all names and addresses reflect each guest's form of identification that they will be asked to bring with them to gain access to the event (e.g. passport, driving licence)

Contact telephone number

In case we need to reach you.

Relationship

Please provide details if you or any of your group are related to a fallen officer.

Photographic ID

Please note that you will need to bring photographic ID with you on the day (warrant card, driving licence or passport)

If you are using a warrant card, your Force number and name of Force will be required, when registering.

Dressing room

A dressing room for uniformed officers is being provided. Please let us know in advance if you will need to use this.

Accessibility information

There are 24 steps at the front of St Paul's Cathedral. Please let us know if you have any accessibility or any disability requirements that we need to consider such as a wheelchairs etc.



The congregation is required to be seated by 2:30pm
